**Cuireann Scoil Aonghusa i gcuimhne ar thuismitheoirí agus caomhnóirí go bhfuil sé tábhachtach teagmháil a dhéanamh leis an scoil díreach má tá ceist ar bith agat faoi ghné ar bith a bhaineann le saol na scoile nó leis an obair bhaile in ionad teachtaireacht nó ráiteas a scríobh ar na meáin shóisialta, grúpaí whatsapp san áireamh. Scoil Aonghusa reminds parents and guardians that instead of writing messages or comments relating to school life, homework etc on a whatsapp group or on social media they **should** direct any question, query, comment or concern directly to the school. proven to be unhelpful and unfair on the children in our care and members of the school community. We thank you for your co-operation with this.

**Iarraimid ort coinne a dhéanamh tríd an oifig má theastaíonn uait bualadh le Múinteoir na scoile i rith na bliana.**

Please make an appointment through the office, if you wish to meet with a teacher at any time throughout the year. It is necessary to make an appointment so that we may give the children in our care our full attention and to minimise disruption to teaching time.

**Rinneadh a lán oibre ar an scoil i rith na laethanta saoire agus níl amhras ar bith ann ach go bhfuil an scoil ag féachaint go maith. Tá ranganna na scoile ag féachaint go hálainn le péint bhreá ar na ballaí agus snas ar an úrlár adhmaid. Tá ríomhairí nua againn freisin. Gabhaim buíochas leis an bhfoireann ar fad a d'oibrigh go dian dícheallach i rith na laethanta saoire chun an obair a chur i gcrích. Ba mhóir an onóir dúinn go raibh Scoil Aonghusa mar ionad i rith Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann.**

The school building is looking very well after an extensive amount of work and refurbishment during the summer months. Five Classrooms were freshly painted and had their floors sanded and varnished. We also have new computers to aid the teaching and learning of the children. I thank the team of people who worked and helped to complete all this work. It was an honour for our school that the Irish conversation and Irish storytelling competitions were held in Scoil Aonghusa during Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann.

**Bíonn Deirdre, ár rúnaí scoile ag obair sa scoil, gach lá ó 8.45 r.n. - 3.15 i.n. Iarraimid ar thuismitheoirí agus cuairteoirí, ár bpríomhdhoras in aice le Ranganna na Naíonán a úsáid i rith an lae scoile. Ar mhaithe le sábháilteacht gach duine sa scoile, iarraimid ar chuairoteoirí chun na scoile iad féin a chur in aithne ag an Oifig i gcónaí.**

Deirdre, our school Secretary works Monday to Friday from 8.45 a.m. — 3.15 p.m. We ask that all parents and visitors use our main entrance at the Infant end of the school, during the school day. In the interest of everybody's safety all visitors to the school must report to the Secretary's Office.

**Is gá duit Deirdre a chur ar an eolas má tá aon athrú ar do shonraí teagmhála – ríomhphost, seoladh nó uimhreacha fóin.**

It is very important that parents inform Deirdre of any changes to their contact details-address, telephone number, e-mail etc.

**Tá go leor deacrachtaí ag baint le fón póca na laethanta seo, ach go háirithe ón am a cuireadh ceamara iontu. Is féidir le fóin fadhbanna bulaíochta agus bulaíocht ar-líne a chothú. Níl cead ag aon pháiste fón póca a thabhairt ar scoil riamh. Má fhaightear amach go bhfuil fón ag páiste ar scoil, tógtar an fón uathu agus beidh ar thuismitheoir/caomhnóir coinne a dhéanamh leis an bPríomhoide chun é a bhailiú ón oifig. Má bhíonn cás ann go bhfuil fón mí-úsáidte sa scoil, cuirfear an Cód Smachta i bhfeidhm ar leibhéal chéim ard.**

These days we see many difficulties arising from the use of mobile phones, in particular since cameras were added to them. Mobile phones can also encourage bullying and cyberbullying problems. If a child is found to have a phone in school, the phone will be removed from their possession. The parent/guardian will have to make an appointment with the Principal to collect the phone. If there is ever a situation where it is found that a phone/camera phone has been misused within the school grounds/during a school activity, it will be treated as a gross misdemeanour through the Code of Behaviour.

Tá múinteoir oideachais speisialta lán-aimseartha agus 2 mhúinteoir oideachais páirtaimseartha againn sa scoil. The school has the services of one full-time and two part-time Special Education Teachers. Múinteoir Cairtriona Ni Dhubhláin is our full-time Special Education Teacher. All children from Infants to Sixth Class are regularly screened through the administration of standardised and observational tests. Parental consultation and support is a vital aspect of our learning support programme.

**If at any time throughout your child's schooling in Scoil Aonghusa you become concerned with any aspect relating to your child's learning, we ask that you do not hesitate to make contact with the class teacher to discuss this.**

I gcomhréir leis an Acht Oideachais (Leas) 2000, beidh gá le tuairisc scríofa a chur go dtí an múinteoir ranga tar éis do pháiste a bheith as láthair. Tá gach lá ar scoil ó thús go deireadh na bliana an-tábhachtach do na páistí agus moltar gan páiste a thógáil ón scoil chun dul ar laethanta saoire le linn an téarma scoile.

In line with The Education (Welfare) Act 2000 parents/guardians are obliged to provide a written explanation to the class teacher following their child's absence from school. Every day, from the beginning to the end of the academic year is important and valuable for the children. For this reason, we strongly advise that children are not taken out of the school during term time to go on holidays.

Please ensure that your child's name is clearly labelled on all jumpers, bags, coats, lunch boxes etc.

Mar Ghaelscoil, tá an Ghaeilge lánach i ngach rud a dhéanaimid sa scoil. Tríd na scoile is í an Ghaeilge an teanga cumarsáide idir dhaltaí agus foireann na scoile. Tá Gaeilge mar chuid lárnach dár gCód Iompair chomh maith. Don chuid is mó, is mealladh agus moladh a bhíonn ar siúl againn chun Gaeilge a chur chun cinn i measc na ndaltaí. Táimid ag brath ar thuismitheoirí tacú

go hiomlán linn leis an nGaeilge a chur chun cinn sa scoil. Glacaimid leis gur don Ghaeilge agus don sár oideachas trí mheán na Gaeilge a roghnaigh sibh Scoil Aonghusa. We ask you to use whatever Irish you have when you are around the school. It is great for the children and for the school community to hear Irish being spoken by you. 
I look forward to meeting with you at our Parent's Association AGM on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> of September at 8 p.m. in the school hall.

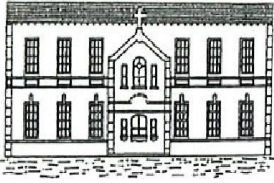
