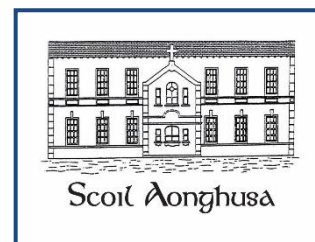


Bord Bainistíochta Tuairisc Bhliantúil an Bhoird Samhain 2020

During the last twelve months the Board of Management has spent a lot of money on the upkeep of the school building, teaching resources, safety equipment and supplies for the good of the school community – 12 new Chromebooks, 2 digital Projectors, 2 printers, 4 teaching laptops, painting of classrooms, new carpet, painting of school railings, new furniture, new books, maths resources, awning for front of library building, fogging machine, sanitiser, cleaning equipment and supplies as outlined in our school's Covid -19 Response Plan. The current project of the Board of Management is the continuous upgrade of digital technology in our school and the redecoration of more classrooms with fresh paint, new

Faoi láthair tá an scoil ag cur béim faoi leith ar shláinte agus ar fholláine an linbh. Mar chuid d'ár bplean feabhsúcháin scoile tá an scoil ag cur an-bhéim ar mhúineadh agus ar fhoghlaim an litriú, léitheoireacht, foclóir matamaitice agus fadhb réiteach sa mhata. Tá portfóilió ag gach páiste agus samplaí d'obair na bpáistí á bhailiú acu. Téann na portfóilió seo ar aghaidh ó bhliain go dtí an chéad scoilbliain eile

Currently, the school is placing particular emphasis on the health and wellbeing of the children. We are also placing an emphasis and focus on the teaching and learning of spelling, reading, Mathematical Language and teaching problem solving strategies. Each child has a portfolio folder and the children have the opportunity to collect samples of their work. These portfolios follow the child from one class year to the next year and therefore track the children's progress.

Tá Curaclam Teanga na Bunscoile á chur i bhfeidhm ó ranganna na Naíonán suas go Rang 6. Tá tuiscint na scoile á fhorbairt ar na haidhmeanna, modhanna múinte, pleanáil agus torthaí foghlama an pháiste mar atá leagtha sa churaclam. Tá fócas láidir ar cad ba chóir go mbeadh ar eolas ag an bpáiste agus cad ba chóir don pháiste a léiriú agus iad i mbun éispéaras foghlama.

The school is implementing the new Primary Language Curriculum for Junior Infants to Sixth Class and is developing an understanding of the aims, approaches, planning and intended learning for children as outlined by the Curriculum. The focus of the curriculum is on what children will know and be able to demonstrate through a range of language experiences and activities. All teachers engaged in in-service training on the Primary Language Curriculum.
